
## PREVENTION OF LUNGWORM

Lungworm or Husk is typically seen in grazing young stock, from mid summer onwards particularly during the first grazing season.

There are a variety of prevention strategies available including the use of anthelmintics either as timed treatments or as long-acting injections or boluses.

These strategies, though very effective do not help the animal to produce a long-term immune response to the worms.

Vaccination is recommended as a way to help provide that



## NEMATODIRUS IN SPRING LAMBS

**Plan ahead to reduce risks**

Nematodirus can cause huge losses in young lambs (less than 12 weeks old) grazing contaminated pastures, if weather conditions allow - this happened in 2013. Problems tend to occur late spring/early summer, if warm weather follows cold and lambs as less than 12 weeks old. Using safe grazing removes the risk of disease. Follow disease forecasts on the NADIS website to tell you the risks for 2015. If risk is high and no safe grazing available, then dose lambs prior to predicted risk period (usually May-June). Almost any dose is effective,

**BUT NOT ORAL MOXIDECTIN (e.g Cydectin)**
